Winter Camping

- ☐ General Equipment List

- ☐ Gloves (2 pairs)
- ☐ Scarf
- ☐ Winter boots
- ☐ Warm socks
- ☐ Long underwear
- ☐ NO shorts

Remember dressing in layers is important!
